Ons spreker was taklid Ode Krige wat ons meer vertel het van haar publikasie Carl Otto Hager (1813-1898) – Argitek tot eer van God.

Carl Otto Hager is in 1813 in Dresden gebore, het weinig vordering gemaak met sy skoolwerk, maar as bedrewe in tekenkuns wat daartoe lei dat hy argitektuur studeer. Hy voltooi sy studies in 1834, maar sukkel om werk te kry weens sy gebrek aan ondervinding en wend hom tot kryt- en potloodstudies, later olieportrette (foto regs).



In 1838 verhuis hy na die Kaap waar hy vir nagenoeg 25 jaar rondval om 'n bestaan te maak – portrette skilder; die bakkersbedryf betree; bliktrommels vernis en blommetjies daarop verf; tekenlesse gegee; blomme en swewende nimfe op bedskerms verf; snuifmaker, kersmaker ...

In 1841 ontvang Carl Sparrman opdrag om planne te teken vir St Mary-katedraal op Stalplein, Kaapstad. Hy benodig Hager se hulp en bied hom 'n vennootskap aan. Hy word egter teen Sparrman gewaarsku en aangeraai om sy eie naam in die geheim êrens op die planne te skryf. Gelukkig het die goedgelewige Hager dié raad aanvaar. Toe Sparrman later bankrot speel en Hager in diskrediet wou bring, kon hy bewys lewer van sy aandeel in die bou van die katedraal.

In 1842 koop W A Krige 'n perseel op die terrein van Stellenbosch Moederkerk en vra vir Hager om vir hom 'n grafkelder te ontwerp en te bou.

In 2007 kry Ode se man, Johan Krige 'n nasaat van W A Krige, goedkeuring om die grafkelder in sy oorspronklike vorm te herbou en die binnerruimte in te rig met 138 nissies vir gebruik deur die Krige-familie. Die boek is die eerste Afrikaanse vertaling van sy lewensherinneringe wat hy geskryf het sonder die nodige leestekens en in 'n geradbraakte taal, 'n vermenging van Nederlands, Duits en die omgangstaal van die tyd.

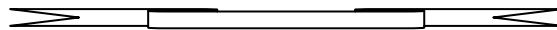

Our guest speaker was Grant McNulty (*photo left*), team member of the Five Hundred Year Archive – a project of the Archive & Public Culture Research Initiative based at the University of Cape Town.

Dit was ook die bekendstelling van taklid Ria van den Heever se publikasie: 'n Keyter – Borchers Collage. Die ontmoeting tussen die twee families. Sien **For the Christmas stocking/Vir die Kerskous** vir meer inligting hieroor.

The focus of the Five Hundred Year Archive (FHYA) is the 500 years before the colonial era with the regional focus on southern Swaziland, KwaZulu-Natal and the North Eastern Cape.

As this period predates written sources, use has been made of physical objects, often dispersed across the globe, as well as other sources relating to this period, such as publications and recordings.

The primary aim of the FHYA is to create an accessible online research portal opened to public comment (scheduled for mid 2016).

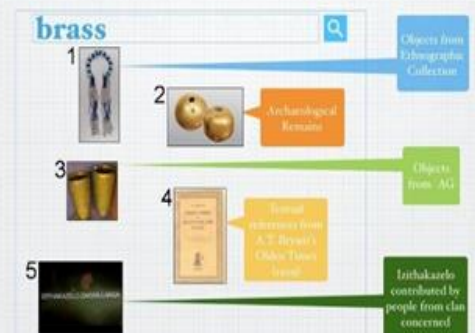

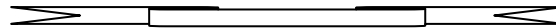

Selecting the pot (*photo right*) will open a window with more information about the pot, such as information about the person who created/collected the pot, the current location, additional information obtained from research and public comments. In Grant's example there were two public comments:

The 1st: These are actually made out of bone and should be called 'amapsumpo'.
The 2nd, a reply to the 1st: No, they are correctly labelled as made out of wood and should be called 'amapsumpa'.

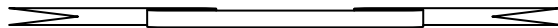

DIE DU PREEZ-FAMILIE IN SUID-AFRIKA

Die Du Preez-familie in Suid-Afrika, saamgestel deur MHC du Preez is die agste in die Genealogiese Publikasiereeks van die Hugenote-Vereniging. Dit is 'n bygewerkte en opdateerde weergawe van Thys du Preez se aanvanklike publikasie, *Die Du Preez-familie in Suid-Afrika: 1688-1988*. Laasgenoemde is in 1988 uitgegee tydens die 300-jarige gedenkjaar van die aankoms van die Hugenote in Suid-Afrika. Hierdie werk het aan hom die DF du Toit Malherbeprys vir Genealogiese Navorsing van die Suid-Afrikaanse Akademie vir Wetenskap en Kuns besorg. Hierna is die werk in 2004 na Engels vertaal en groei dit tot 899 bladsye. Hierdie nuwe uitgawe het nou gegroei na 1508 bladsye en met 18 842 inskrywings. Dit beslaan nou drie volumes. Deel 1 handel oor die stamvader en sy seuns se vestiging in Suid-Afrika en 'n groot deel word ook gewy aan die du Preez's se deelname aan die Anglo-Boereoorlog. 'n Naamindeks word ook in Deel 1 weergegee. Deel 2 en 3 bevat die familieregister. 'n Hele aantal foto's is ook ingesluit in die werk.

Die boek het 'n aantrekklike sagte omslag, ongeveer 200 bladsye in A4 formaat met so 60 kleurillustrasies en nog ander in swart en wit. Ek het dit so aantreklik en leesbaar moontlik probeer maak. Die skryftaal is Afrikaans met baie aanhalings in Engels en selfs Hollands.

Die storie fokus op die ontmoeting tussen die Keyter- en Borcherds families in die huwelik tussen Bernardus Johannes Keyter junior * 1856 en Wilhelmina Maria Elizabeth Borcherds ook * 1856. Ek behandel die voor- sate van lede van die egpaar sowel as hulle nageslag., aan die hand van baie navorsing oor die familielede.

Ek probeer om die leser meer te bied as 'n blote geslagsregister deur die familielede wat bespreek word uit te bou tot volledige mense deur informasie oor hul grootwordjare, opvoeding, onderrig, eggenote, beroepslewe, persoonlikhede, waardes en verdere noemenswaardige doen en late, in te sluit.

Ek het moeite gedoen om bestaande informasie/ stories ens. op te volg wat soms gelei het tot staving van die feite of andersins geen sub- stans kon toevoeg nie. Stories het soms baie interessante draaie gemaak.

Daar is ook hoofstukke wat gewy is aan huldeblyke aan twee afstammeling van die egpaar nl. Valerie Keyter en Ena Meintjes in voldoening aan 'n ooreenkoms wat ek aangegaan het met Ena voordat sy oorlede is. Meer daaroor word in die boek vertel.

Title: 'n Keyter-Borcherds Collage. Die ontmoeting tussen die twee families.

The book has an attractive soft cover, approximately 200 pages in A4 format, 60 odd illustrations in colour and more in black and white. I tried to present it as attractively and readable as possible. It is written in Afrikaans with many quotations in English and even in Dutch.

*The story focuses on the connection between the Keyter and Borcherds families in the marriage between Bernardus Johannes Keyter junior * 1856 and Wilhelmina Maria Elizabeth Borcherds also * 1856. I discuss their ancestors as well as their offspring.*

I try to offer the reader more than a mere register of names by elaborating on the childhood, upbringing, education, marriage partners, profes- sional lives, personalities, values and further activities and traits worth a mention of the ancestors and family members included in the book.

I went to plenty of trouble to examine existing information and stories with a view to either verifying them and elaborating on them or discard- ing them. Stories sometimes took very interesting turns.

Further chapters are dedicated to two descendants of the couple, namely Valerie Keyter and Ena Meintjes, in compliance with an agreement made with Ena before her demise. More about that in the book.

Wine, Women & Good Hope A History of Scandalous Behaviour in the Cape June McKinnon

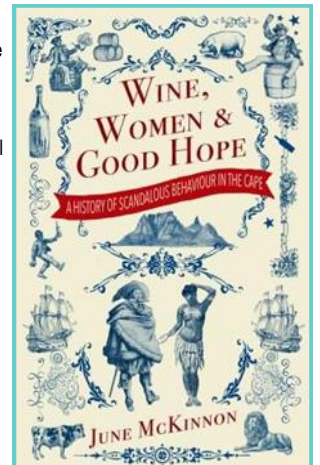
"Wine, Women and Good Hope" is a romp through the more salacious history of the Cape of Good Hope, where alcohol flowed freely, reputations were frequently in tatters, and sex was on offer to anyone looking to have a good time. Even the likes of Jan van Riebeeck, Cecil

John Rhodes and Barney Barnato feature in some of these accounts.

The arrival of the Dutch at the Cape in the seventeenth century had far-reaching consequences for its indigenous inhabitants as well as the European settlers, who together have contributed to the mixed heritage of most South African families. June McKinnon uses her expertise as a genealogist to trace the lineages of many well-known family trees and to overturn the notion that those who lived in the past were nobler or had more sense than their modern descendants.

Encompassing tales that are both humorous and tragic in their revelations of past misdeeds, this book will give you access to the little-known history of the Cape of Good Hope. A highly entertaining read that offers a fresh and engaging view of life at the tip of Africa.

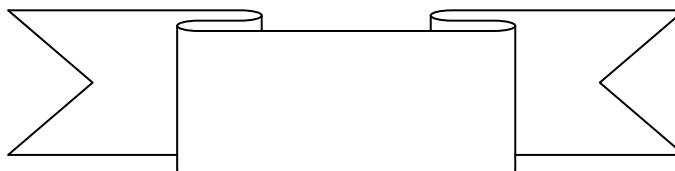

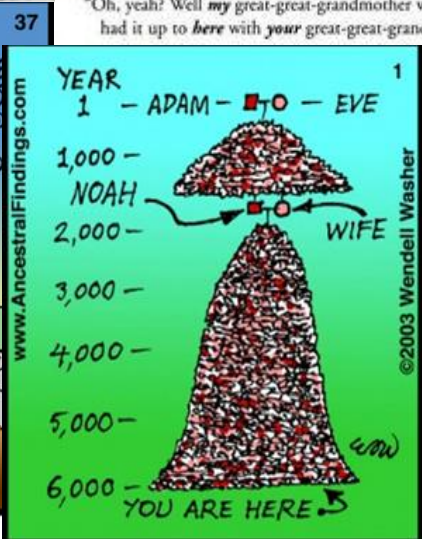
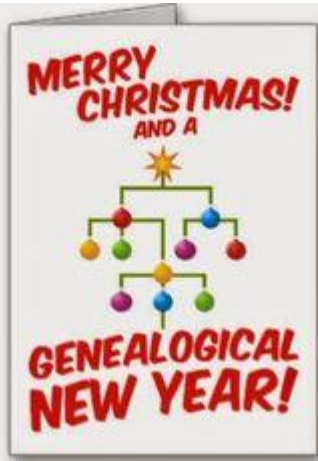
